Boy Scouts of America Declaration of Religious Principle:

I further understand that I must have a current medical examination prior to camp and must provide myself with at least two full scout uniforms.

All employees should be available for the whole season, unless otherwise arranged.

All staff members under the age of 18 must provide a current Pennsylvania work permit.
