The Northeastern Pennsylvania Council invites you to participate in *Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills*, a fun-filled program of hands-on skills training in the outdoors, designed to help you master basic camp skills required for Tenderfoot to First Class.

Instructors will help you learn how to set up camp, cook, work with woods tools and about ropes, first aid, planning campfire programs, map reading and compass skills, hiking and packing techniques, nature identification, and Leave No Trace. Each outdoor session will bring life to the pages of the *Boy Scout Handbook* to help you deliver the promise of Scouting to yourself and the youth you serve. It will increase your comfort level and give you confidence as a trained, skilled leader. The program will also give you the opportunity to work with other Scout leaders from your area, meet new friends, and reinforce skill techniques with fellow unit leaders.

**\$25 per person covers registration, handouts, beverages and snacks; and all food needed for the Outdoor Weekend.**

Please reference the outdoor camping equipment list in the Boy Scout handbook, plus, bring a camp chair. You will also need a BSA Personal Health and Medical Record - Class 1 form, No. 34414 (which will need to be turned in during morning registration at camp). This form does not have to be signed by a doctor. Please let us know if you have any physical limitations or special dietary or medical needs so we can be prepared before the course begins.

We look forward to hearing from you and working with you in this unique and exciting program and "pass the word" to other Boy Scout Leaders. We don't want anyone to miss out on the fun.

**Completion of Scoutmaster and Asst. Scoutmaster Leader Specific Training and Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills is required for a Scoutmaster or Assistant Scoutmaster to be considered "Trained" and is a "pre-requisite" for attendance at Wood Badge. Although specifically designed to meet the needs of Scoutmasters and Assistant Scoutmasters, this course is also suggested for Committee Members, Webelos Leaders and other interested Scouters. (This course may also be taken as a stand-alone training.)**
