



2008 Historic Traveling Camporee *Williamsburg, VA*

~ Information Sheet for Participants Staying at the Hotel ~

Following is information for those participants who, for one reason or another, are not able to camp out with the rest of the Traveling Camporee contingent. This service is provided with the understanding that it will not be abused. Participants will travel with the bus drivers from the campsite to the hotel and back again in the morning. It will be your responsibility to be ready and on time, so that our schedule will not be compromised.

Our bus drivers will be staying at the **Ramada, Outlet Mall**, near where we are camping at Chickahominy Riverfront Park. **You are to contact John at 1-757-565-1111.** Make sure you tell him you are with the Boy Scout contingent from Northeastern Pennsylvania, coming to Williamsburg on Columbus Day Weekend, October 11th – 13th. **The confirmation number for our group is #40776.**

Following is information that *you need to understand* before agreeing to stay at the hotel.

- This is a weekend campout. Even though we are traveling by bus, it is still a campout. It is not a vacation. It is not designed for entertainment for adults. It is an educational trip for our Scouts, a living history lesson. The adults that participate in the trip are there as chaperones for their Scouts, and it is expected that they will do everything they can to make this happen.
- **All** participating adults **MUST** be registered with a troop. If there are parents in your troop who would like to go on the trip (that are not currently registered), they will have to fill out an adult registration form and pay the pro-rated fee until the end of your charter year.
- You must be able to carry your own luggage. Luggage should be limited to not more than one or two bags, whatever you can carry. Space is limited! Carry-ons are okay.
- After arriving at the camping area on Saturday evening, **be prepared to carry your luggage to the hotel bus as soon as everyone has their equipment unloaded.** You are to **immediately** board the hotel bus for departure. We want to make it clear to everyone that the drivers should not have to wait around for anyone. They are on a set schedule. When they are ready to leave, they will leave – regardless of whether everyone is ready or not. If anyone misses the bus, they will have to call for a taxi.
- All troops attending must have 2-deep leadership. This is BSA policy. If your troop only has two leaders attending, and you are one of them, you will not be allowed to stay at the hotel. There must be two leaders in the campsite with your unit.
- Make sure your luggage is marked or recognizable to you in some way that will make it easy to spot and thereby save time sorting it out.
