Additional information

1. **Medical Forms for each participant must be with the unit leader at the event.**
2. **Registration packet including patches and meal ticket will be given to the person you designate as your unit contact on your registration form.**
3. **Webelos are encouraged to participate in the Webelos (Western) Challenge, which will begin after the Opening Ceremony. Medals will be awarded to the patrols that earn the most points!**
4. All pre-registered Cub Scouts will receive one cup of hot chocolate, one cup of soup, and one Hot Dog as part of their registration. The Group leader will receive food tickets for all the participants from the pack when they report to the registration area. (This includes the adult and sibling tickets as well)
5. Additional food will be available for purchase under the pavilion, hosted by the NEPA Order of the Arrow
6. **Please dress for the weather: This event is held outdoors.** Bring extra clothes - Gloves, socks, and boots.
7. Heavy rain on the day of the event, heavy snowfall within 8-10 hours prior to the event, or extremely cold wind chill factors will cancel the event. – Look to the council webpage for details on the day of the event. In the event of cancellation, the Unit Contact person will be contacted.
8. The buddy system will be in effect and packs need to have 1 adult for every 8 youth.
9. Participant parking will be at the parking lot and on the road.
10. Webelos leaders, it is suggested that you bring a hot drink and snack for your cubs. This will help keep them going.

1. What are the three types of poisonous plants? - 3 points
2. What are the two most important things to do to stop a cut from bleeding? - 5 points
3. Explain the buddy system and why it is important. - 5 points
4. What are the 4 Hurry Cases? - 5 points
5. What is the universal sign for choking and how can you help a victim? - 5 points
6. How to treat hypothermia? - 5 points
7. How to treat heat stroke? - 5 points
8. Name the rules of "Leave No Trace" - 5 points
9. Demonstrate the following knots: overhand, square, bowline, clove hitch, taut line, two half hitch - 5 points for each knot; 3 points if knot requires assistance. **Ropes will be provided for fair judging.**

Event Completion:

Webelos will have 3 timed events where they will have 15 minutes to complete the activity.

1. The Cowboy Knot – The sheriff needs all their deputies to be able to work together. Webelos must prove themselves by participating in the Human Knot! (Requires communication and ability to follow directions)
2. Above the Horizon – When looking for bandits on the western plane the sheriff requires their deputies to find their way and tell what direction they are going. With a compass, orient yourself to give the direction of the landmark where you and your crew must go to. (Know how to orient yourself along with North, South, East, and West. Please bring a compass)
3. Set up Base Camp – Use materials they brought to create a shelter big enough for all of your team members (Note that there are NO trees in the Webelos Challenge area! Please bring materials to stand the tent!)
 - a. 5 points if large enough (3 points if not)
 - b. 5 points if appears to be able to protect the team from rain/snow (3 points if not)
 - c. 20 points if stable enough to protect against Marauders!!! (Judge will gently shake the structure to make sure it is stable and won't EASILY fall apart) 10 Points if attempt is made but it is not stable.
4. Teamwork:
 - Showed good listening and respect when others were talking (+1) _____
 - Did not bully or "poke fun" of others (including other Patrols at station) (+1) _____
