Overview & Schedule

Scouts can attend up to 3 sessions to work on Adventure pins or fun STEM activities. This is a Saturday program (September 23rd), but Scouts should try to register as a pack/den so we can guarantee you are in the same sessions together all day. Camping is optional Friday-Sunday (September 22nd-24th) or scouts can be dropped off and picked up after the Closing Ceremony. Scouts can select up to 3 sessions being offered and the session runs about 2 hours approximately following the schedule below. (Please do not come to the registration table earlier than 8 AM on Saturday). Packs must have a BALOO Trained Leader to camp over.

Registration & Sign Up

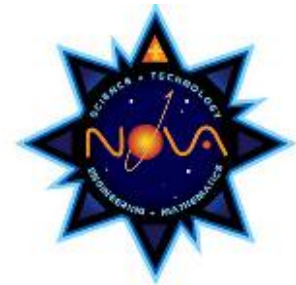
Pre-registration is required. No walk-ins will be accepted. Session sizes are limited, register early to reserve your spot in your first-choice session selections. All registrations and payments must be made in advance through the Service Center. We will take registrations up to Saturday, September 16th. Registrations will be accepted after September 17th but will be subject to session availability.

Use the registration forms at the end of this packet to sign up. Scouts will be asked to select a first choice and an alternate for each session in case something becomes filled. We will confirm a final schedule as soon as possible after registering.

The fee to attend this event is \$10 by Saturday, September 9th or \$15 by Saturday, September 16th. This fee includes lunch, a patch and program. All payments must be made in advance through the Service Center, we will not be collecting any funds on site. Please complete and submit your completed camping application to Service Center when registering or prior for a specific campsite.

Check-In/Drop Off

Please follow the directions of our Parking Staff. Check-in will begin no earlier than 5:00 PM on Friday or 8:00 AM on Saturday. All Scout/Parents should check in at the Administration building. Group leadership will be given schedules and patches. Pack Leadership is responsible for ensuring that a completed medical form (parts A & B) is on hand for every individual in their group.

Check- Out/Pick up

Parents will park again in the parking lot. For scouts only coming for the Saturday only, the event ends at 5:15 PM and Scouts should be ready for pick up no later than 5:30 PM. Please arrive for pick up no later than 5:30 PM and follow direction from staff. Packs/dens staying the weekend are asked to leave camp no later than noon on Sunday. Please have your campsite completely cleaned and take your trash with you.

Meals

Lunch on Saturday will be provided and served in the dining hall. All other meals will be prepared by units in their campsites. Please plan accordingly for Friday dinner, Saturday breakfast and dinner, and Sunday breakfast. Please be prepared to cook meals on a camp stove or raised grill. Please use established fire rings in campsite. If your campsite does not have a fire ring, please share with neighboring den/pack.

Uniforms

'Class B' Uniforms are encouraged during the event, but Scouts should dress primarily for the weather and the activities they will be doing.

- ✓ Completed BSA Medical form, parts A & B only are needed.
- ✓ Backpack or day pack
- ✓ 2 filled water bottles
- ✓ Small bottle of hand sanitizer
- ✓ Pens & notebook
- ✓ Watch (Phones are ok if Scouts wish to bring them to call/check in with parent)
- ✓ Sunscreen/sunglasses
- ✓ Insect repellent (non-aerosol)
